All unsolicited submissions are blind peer-reviewed. Decision time is normally four to six months. There is no monetary payment for publication, but the author will receive one complimentary copy of the volume in which the article appears and a one-year digital subscription to VII.

Beginning with a small number of books and fifteen letters by C.S. Lewis, the Marion E. Wade Center now holds thousands of manuscripts, letters, first editions, and other primary materials.

Fifteen years later, in 1980, Dr. Barbara Reynolds,
Dr. Beatrice Batson, and Dr. Kilby founded
